NOTICE TO ALL GOLD BUYING LICENSEES

COMPLIANCE NOTICE NO. GOLDBOD/2026/04

It has come to the attention of the Ghana Gold Board (“GoldBod”) that some gold buying licensees are not complying with the reporting obligations stated in the terms and conditions of their licence.

The GoldBod reminds all gold buying licensees that they are mandated to prepare and submit to the GoldBod monthly transaction reports detailing all the daily gold purchases, the quantity, purity, value, and other activities conducted within the reporting period.

The monthly transaction reports should be submitted to the GoldBod within 15 days after the end of every month. As such, gold buying licensees were required to submit their report for the month of January 2026 by 15th February 2026.

All gold buying licensees are hereby reminded that failure to comply with any term or condition of their licence is a ground for revocation of the licence and an offence under section 63 of the Ghana Gold Board Act, 2025.

GoldBod remains committed to enforcing the laws and regulations that govern the gold trading sector in the spirit of accountability and transparency.
